Please be sure to include in any oral or written announcement of this dispensation the following suggested text:

*"A dispensation from the Lenten obligation to abstain from meat has been granted by the Archdiocese of New York to all Catholics attending the City Island Sail & Power Squadron, Annual Change of Watch dinner, scheduled for April 5, 2019.*

*There is a serious obligation for Catholics to observe abstinence from meat on Lenten Fridays in a substantial way. Therefore, those who are dispensed should substitute another fitting penitential practice in its place, especially a work of charity, prayer personal sacrifice."*
